Museum Sidetable is a height-adjustable table in aluminum and steel. It has a variety of uses: Flower pedestal, small extra table by the sofa, bedside table, hallway table and more. The table is manufactured and distributed by String Furniture and is designed by Swedish TAF Studio.

Weight recommendation

10 kg evenly spread across the product.

Materials and colors

The parts are made of aluminum and steel and then powder coated in different colors.

Production

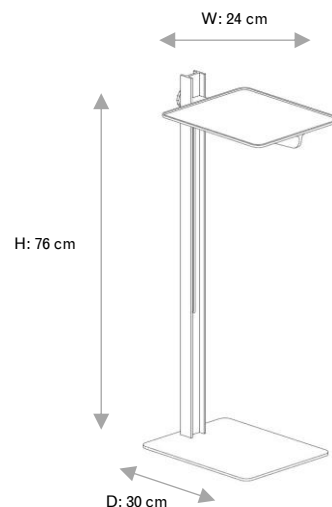
Molded in China, lacquered and packed in Sweden

Sustainability

Due to the aluminum and steel, the product is 100% recyclable.

Care and maintenance

Wipe the surface with a cloth. Damp wipe with detergent solution. Then rub dry with a cloth. Remove stains with detergents that do not contain abrasives. Never use steel wool.
